



FINDING HIDDEN MONEY WORKSHEET

Most of us have money sitting right in front of us and don't even realize it is there. Let's go find it! Take about 15 minutes and go on treasure hunt. Here are some ideas of where to start looking. Some of these are physical money or items and others are things that have value. THEY ALL COUNT! Each and every time I do this exercise, I am amazed at what I uncover.

To get you started, here is a list of ideas of what to look for:

- Loose change and bills laying around the house

- Bank accounts you may have forgotten about

 - Gifts from family or friends
 - Dividends paid on investments
 - Family or group investments
 - Affiliate income or commissions
- Checks you may have forgotten to cash
- Clients you forgot to invoice or have been putting off invoicing

Past due invoices that just need a call or email

Credit card or bank reward points – redeem these for cash or products

This list is just the beginning – look for anything that has value! Remember – it all counts! Add up the total of what you find on your treasure hunt.

After you search for what is already right in front of you, the next step is to look at what could be created with just a little inspired action. Some ideas to get you going...

Client leads – is there someone you need to call or email?
